



San Francisco's New Argonne Clubhouse & Playground Completed by Diamond Certified Rose Construction

FAIRFAX, CA -- (MARKET WIRE) -- March 27, 2007 -- Rose Construction today announced the completed construction of the new Argonne Clubhouse and Playground located at 455 18th Avenue in San Francisco's Richmond District. - Basketball & tennis courts
- A toddlers' play area with swings & a sandbox
- Picnic, stage, & grassy areas
- A clubhouse for indoor activities with a full kitchen, an office, a reading area, & bi-fold doors that open to the outdoors as weather permits

Notably, Rose Construction exceeded the requirements set forth by the City of San Francisco's Waste Recovery, Recycle, and Reuse Program, and they opened the park on schedule despite challenging 2006 weather conditions.
